

Petrochemical Facility Installs Century's Railroad Spill Containment Pans

A Niagara Falls, New York petrochemical facility installed Century's high density polyethylene enviropans in their railroad tank car loading/unloading facility. The project featured Century's 12' wide HDPE spill collection pans with standard cross drains with 6" discharge outlets. The Century spill containment pans feature the most advanced technology helping industry with railroad tank car transloading racks meet EPA's SPCC (Spill Prevention Control and Countermeasures) Plan.

The spill containment pans also featured safety yellow fiberglass grating which was laid in the bottom of the pans to prevent contact with any accidental liquid spills.
