

## Century Group Inc. Provides Railroad Spill Containment for Class I Railroad

Century Group Inc. the leading manufacturer of railroad spill containment pans, recently manufactured and delivered its HDPE Enviropans to a Class I railroad for use in a railroad maintenance and rail car wash facility in Kansas City, Missouri. The project included Century's HDPE railroad spill pans which were installed adjacent to a rail car wash facility to catch water dripping as the locomotives and railcars exited the car wash facility.

The project featured 390 track feet of the spill containment pans with a width of 12' and gasketed cross drains in tracks with 132# rail on wood ties. The Century HDPE Enviropans are considered a best management practice in helping Class I and shortline railroads be compliant with SPCC requirements under the EPA Clean Water Act regulations.
